Mr. Adam Singer

Adam Singer is a native of Bassett, Virginia, where he attended Bassett High School. He is a graduate of the University of North Carolina at Greensboro with a Bachelor of Music in Music Education. While at UNCG, he participated in the University Band, Symphonic Band, Wind Ensemble, Sinfonia Orchestra, Jazz Band, Pit Orchestra, and Trumpet Ensemble. He studied trumpet under Dr. Edward Bach and Mr. Mark Clodfelter. He was a member and officer of Phi Mu Alpha Music Fraternity. Mr. Singer participated in The Cadets Drum and Bugle Corps from 2011-2013, winning the drum corps 10th World Championship in 2011.

Mr. Singer started his career teaching 6th-8th grade band, theatre, and general music at P.S. Jones Middle School in Washington, NC. From there, he became the Associate Director of Bands at South Caldwell High School in Hudson, NC. While he was there, he co-taught concert bands, AP Music Theory, Jazz Band, Marching Band, and Percussion Ensemble. In 2017, he began teaching at Cox Mill High School. Mr. Singer teaches Concert Band, Symphonic Band, Wind Ensemble, Jazz Band, Pit Orchestra, and the Spirit of Cox Mill Marching Band. While at ox Mill, the band has received multiple first-place awards at local marching band competitions and continues to receive excellent and superior ratings at NC MPA Concert Festival.

Mr. Singer currently resides in Concord, NC with his wife, Chelsea, and their two pets Mia and Cooper.

Mr. Chris White

Chris White is a native of Bristol, Tennessee. He attended Bridgewater College in Bridgewater, VA, where he received the Bachelor of Arts in Music degree in 1997, graduating with Magna Cum Laude honors. He began his graduate studies as a Graduate Teaching Assistant to University Bands at Radford University, where he studied trumpet and conducting with Mark Camphouse. After moving to Charlotte, NC to begin his teaching career, he finished his graduate studies at Winthrop University as a student of Dr. Bill Malambri, where he earned the Master of Music in Instrumental Conducting degree. He became a National Board Certified teacher in 2006, and re-certified in 2016.

Mr. White has been the Director of Bands at Hickory Ridge High School in Harrisburg, NC since the school opened in the fall of 2007. Mr. White's duties at Hickory Ridge include overseeing a comprehensive band program which consists of multiple concert ensembles, jazz ensemble, marching band, musical pit orchestra, and several small ensembles, and Advanced Placement Must Theory. Prior to his appointment at Hickory Ridge, Mr. White taught for six years in the Charlotte-Mecklenburg school system.

Under his direction, ensembles at Hickory Ridge consistency receive superior ratings at marching, concert, jazz, and solo festivals. The Hickory Ridge Blue Regiment has twice performed in the prestigious London New Year's Day Parade. In 2018, the Hickory Ridge Wind Ensemble participated in a ten day performance tour of China at the invitation of the US-China Cultural and Educational Foundation, where they presented a series of public concerts in Shanghai, Shaoxin, Jiaxin, and Beijing. The Blue Regiment is an invited guest for the 2020 Rome Parade, and will perform in both Rome and Frascati, Italy as a part of this event. In addition, over the past thirteen years, Mr. White's concert ensembles have performed in Washington, D.C., New York, Orlando, and New Orleans.

Mr. White was selected as Hickory Ridge High School Teacher of the Year in 2015, and was a top five finalist for Cabarrus County Schools Teacher of the Year. He has previously received recognition as Charlotte-Mecklenburg New Band Director of the Year in 1999. He was also recognized as 2001 E.E. Waddell High School Teacher of the Year, and received the Horace Mann Crystal Apple Award for outstanding teaching. He has served as clinician, adjudicator, and guest conductor for many marching and concert events. He is currently the Chair of the South Central District Bandmasters Association and.

Mr. White's professional memberships include the American School Band Directors Association (ASBDA), North Carolina Music Educators Association (NCMEA), South Carolina Music Educators Association (SCDBA), and the National Association of Music Education (NAfME). He is also a member of Phi Mu Alpha (Alpha Zeta Chapter), Pi Kappa Lambda, and Omicron Delta Kappa fraternities.
